



Iron Mountain Hot Springs is Now a National Natural Landmark

Glenwood Springs, Colo. (April 24, 2024) - This year the 16 geothermal pools at [Iron Mountain Hot Springs](#) received the [National Natural Landmark](#) (NNL) designation, recognizing the property as an outstanding example of biological and geological features. Iron Mountain's hot mineral springs are home to a diverse suite of microorganisms and were formed with unique underground processes that show millions of years of geologic history. The site is deemed nationally significant based on its outstanding condition, illustrative character, rarity, diversity and value to science and education.

"We are honored by the National Natural Landmark designation and so happy to continue to offer guests the opportunity to experience these natural wonders," said founder and owner Steve Beckley.

In recognition of the designation, visitors can take advantage of 20% off the [NNL combo ticket](#) which includes a three-hour soak at Iron Mountain Hot Springs plus a guided cave tour of Glenwood Caverns, an integral part of the site's geological significance.

At [WorldSprings](#), the adults-only section of Iron Mountain Hot Springs, guests ages 21 and older can enjoy 10 pebble-bottomed Inspired Pools along the Colorado River, a cold plunge pool, a Dead Sea pool, a waterfall freshwater pool and new Sandbar Cafe. Each Inspired Pool is filled with a famous hot spring mineral formula from locations across the globe, giving visitors the opportunity to experience the healing properties of these well-known pools. Mineral formulas from Iceland, France, Japan, the United Kingdom, Turkey, Romania, Australia, Bali, Italy, New Zealand and South Korea are featured on rotation, each with their own unique mineral makeup and healing properties.

One year since its opening WorldSprings continues to roll out new features and has additional expansion plans for the future. In the meantime, a new mobile ordering amenity is in place for guests. They can simply scan a QR code sign near their pool and select menu options to order and input payment information. Once the order is ready, patrons will receive a text message allowing them to pick up their food and drinks at both the Sandbar and Sopris Cafe windows.
