## **Iron Mountain Hot Springs to Expand its WorldSprings Section**

The property will soon break ground on new pools, saunas and cabanas

Glenwood Springs, Colo. (October 23, 2024) - [Iron Mountain Hot Springs](#) is excited to announce new additions coming in 2025. The luxury hot springs property will be adding a variety of new pools ranging in temperatures from 55°F-104°F and multiple saunas to its [WorldSprings](#) section and will add family-friendly cabanas to its General Access section.

“We are thrilled to bring these new offerings to our guests,” said Aaron McCallister, General Manager. “With the health benefits of hot and cold therapy becoming more popular, we want to ensure our guests have an optimal experience at our property. This means more pools and high-quality amenities to choose from.”

These new features add to Iron Mountain’s existing 32 geothermal, freshwater and inspired pools, [two cafes](#) and [luxury bathhouse](#). The 2025 expansion is part of the property’s larger future plans to develop an additional two acres of property to better serve its guests.

Iron Mountain Hot Springs opened WorldSprings in June 2023. The 21-years and older section of the property features 10 inspired pools – eight of which are along the Colorado River – a cold plunge pool, a large freshwater pool with water features, a large Dead Sea pool with a waterfall and food and beverage offerings at the Sandbar café. The inspired pools utilize mineral recipes crafted from well-known hot springs around the globe, such as the Blue Lagoon in Iceland and Hokkaido Island pools in Japan. Each pebble-bottomed inspired pool offers its own unique mineral makeup and healing properties, giving visitors a chance to experience hot springs from around the world in one centralized location.

Iron Mountain Hot Springs’ legacy section includes 16 geothermal Iron Mountain mineral soaking pools, an inspired pool, jetted spa and a freshwater family pool. Thoughtful amenities are built in throughout, including towel tree sculptures at each soaking pool, changing rooms stocked with complimentary shower products and the original Sopris Cafe. The legacy side of the property has also recently been designated as a [National Natural Landmark](#) by the National Park Service thanks to the natural hot spring’s rare biological and unique geological features.

In November the hot springs plans to introduce new annual pass offerings at a discounted rate for guests to enjoy access Monday through Thursday. A special “Slope and Soak” ticket with Sunlight Ski Resort offered at a discounted rate will also be available for purchase before the end of the year.
